


Updated Emergency Regulations

- Local water agency mandating25% reduction from July 2013 usage
- Implement the county's Water
 Shortage Contingency Plan
 containing mandatory restrictions on
 the number of days of outdoor
 irrigation
- Eliminate Washing of hardscape
- Eliminate Irrigation runoff





District Priorities and Plans



- Prioritize landscaped areas for water use curtailments
- Leak detection and repair
- Restrict watering days per regulations
- Utilize drought resistant plants
- Remove grass areas when possible and replace with mulch
- Exploring low flush toilets
 - Ideas with viable water savings may result in rebate incentives.
