### LCP (Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan)

#### LCAP versus LCP

Under SB98, the development of a Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) was suspended for the 2020-2021 school year. In its place, the district is required to develop a Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan, which covers seven areas:

1. In-person Instructional Offerings
2. Distance Learning Program
3. Pupil Learning Loss
4. Mental Health and Social Emotional Well Being
5. Professional Development
6. Pupil Engagement and Outreach
7. School Nutrition

  - Learning loss strategies
    - Support staff working with small groups
    - Wednesday early release and teachers working with small groups
  - Effectiveness of Learning Loss Strategies
    - How are they or will they work and how will we know.
- How will the district monitor:
  - Mental health and Social emotional needs?
    - Work with counseling and Program Specialist to work in classes
  - Pupil and Family Engagement and Outreach
    - Bilingual aides checking in with families
    - Find out what resources they need
    - Healthy Family Updates from District Office
    - School sites sending out information in primary language
  - School Nutrition
    - Summer Seamless Program
      - Serve all school age children 1-18
      - Fridays will be served for 3 days to make sure they have meals through the weekend
