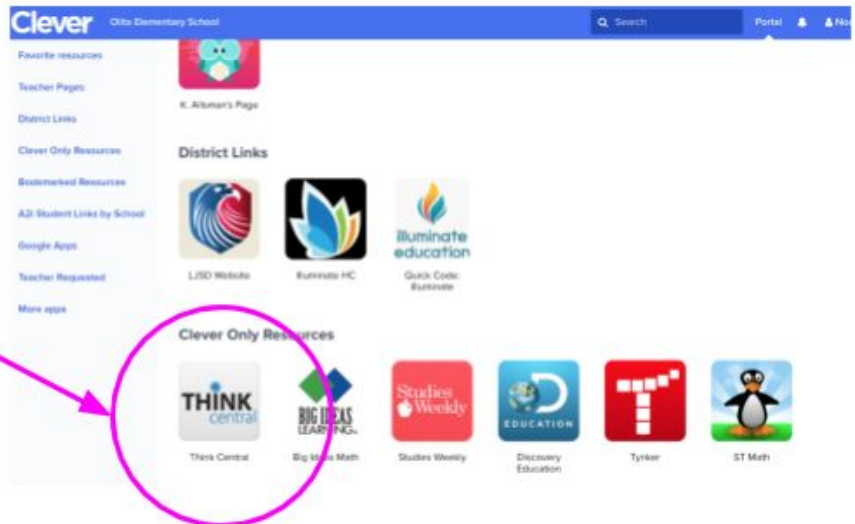


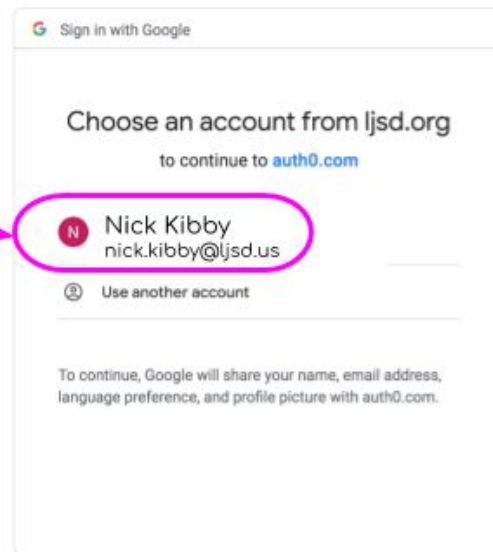
Logging onto Think Central from Clever

1. From your students Clever homepage they will scroll down and click on the Think Central tile.

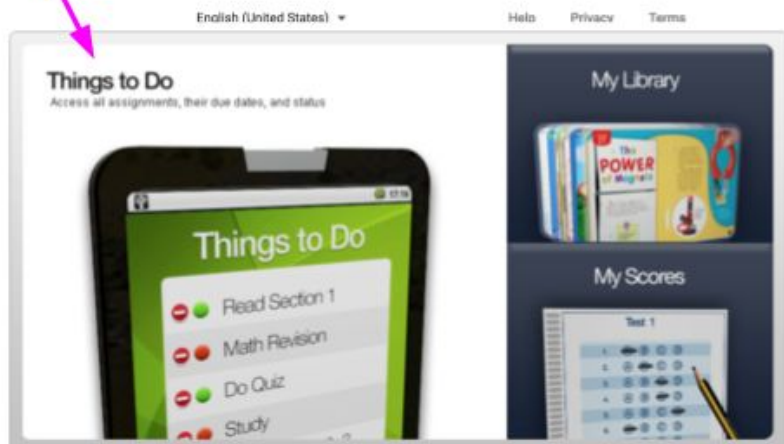
(This will take you to both Reading and Math materials for your student.)



2. You may be asked to verify your students account at this point. Click on their school email.

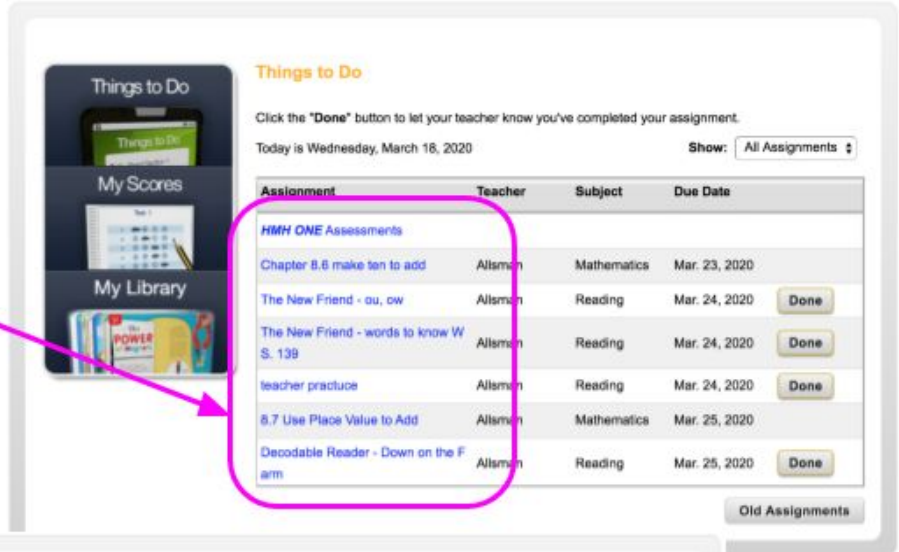


3. Student should click on "Things to Do" in order to find their assignments.

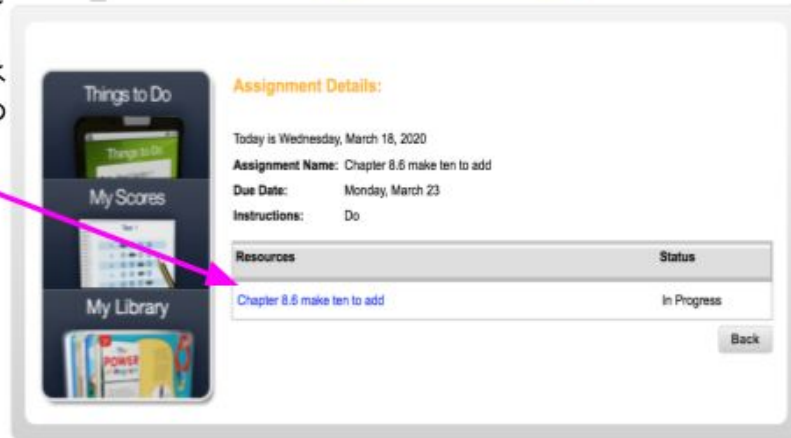

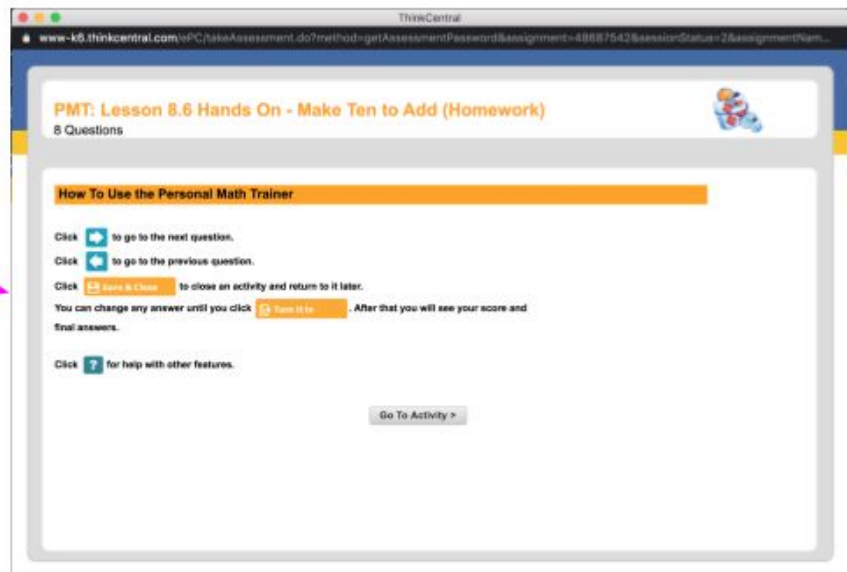
4. On the "Things to Do" page you will find what has been assigned to your student. They will click on the links to complete their work.



5. Once you click on an assignment you will see assignment details with a due date and instructions. Click on the blue link to continue.




6. Students will first come to a screen that gives some basic controls for working through the lesson.
