When will we receive a Driver Education Certificates (MV-285) upon completion of the course?

The certificates usually take 3-4 weeks after completion of the course. All 285 completion certificates will be mailed to the student's address listed on the registration form.

1. Who may enroll?

- a. Resident of Lynbrook Public Schools (District 20) get first priority.
- b. Students must be16 years of age and older. Students must possess a valid New York State

Learner's Permit, prior to the class start date. You may register without a learners permit, but you WILL **NOT RECEIVE A REFUND,** if you do not get a permit in time for the class.

2. What if I lose my 285 Completion Certificate?

A completion certificate should be stored in a safe place. If a completion certificate is lost, it can take a minimum of six weeks to get a replacement certificate. Please contact Eric Finder to get a replacement certificate after all avenues of finding the certificate have been exhausted.

3. What is the course?

- a. New York State Education Department approved and recognized by NYSDMV(semester course)
- b. Fall Semester (Sept-Jan) Spring Semester (Feb-June) Summer Semester (July-Aug)
- c. 24 hours of classroom instruction
- d. 24 hours of in-car sessions (six of which are behind the wheel)

4. When are classes conducted? Students preference considered whenever possible, no guarantees.

- a. 6:00 AM before school- car lessons
- b. 3:30 PM after school car lessons
- c. Saturday and Sunday (cars lessons only) (Times in the AM TBD by enrollment)
- d. 5:00 or 7:00 Monday Thursday lecture

5. What will the successful student receive?

a. Certificate of Completion that allows you to obtain a license at age 17, and may qualify for auto insurance discounts

6. How to enroll Registration Guidelines: No exceptions!

- a. Fully complete the application
- b. Return the completed application form during the announced time posted at Lynbrook High School (Cafeteria) with all information, signatures requested and a check made out to the Lynbrook School District

7. Are there any fees?

- a. Yes, it costs \$575 for District 20 residents, \$675 for non-District 20 residents (subject to change) all checks must be payable to the Lynbrook School District.
- b. Return the completed application form and check or money order during time announced and posted at Lynbrook High School (Cafeteria).

8. Where will the course be offered?

- a. Classroom instruction at Lynbrook High School in room 205 or 207
- b. In-car instruction will begin at Lynbrook High School (Teacher Parking Lot), and utilize local roads and parkways
- c. Following registration lecture and driving schedules will be posted on the District website
