Course Description	In this intermediate middle school art class, students will improve their skills and explore different art materials, working on more challenging projects. The course focuses on personal creativity and preparing students for higher-level art.
Course Objectives	<ul> <li>Enhance Artistic Techniques: Students will refine their skills in drawing, painting, and sculpture through advanced practice and experimentation with various materials and methods.</li> <li>Foster Creative Expression: Students will develop their unique artistic voices, creating original works that reflect personal ideas, emotions, and perspectives.</li> <li>Cultivate Critical Thinking: Students will analyze and critique their own work and that of others, learning to give and receive constructive feedback to improve their art.</li> </ul>
Classroom Expectations	<ol> <li>No cell phones allowed during instructional time.</li> <li>Be seated and ready for class when the bell rings. Students tardy to class will receive a detention per LMS policy.</li> <li>Come prepared for class. Bring all necessary supplies.</li> <li>Respect your teacher, your classmates, the classroom supplies, and yourself.</li> <li>If it's not yours, don't touch it. Keep your hands and feet to yourself.</li> </ol> All students must follow the Madison City Schools Code of Conduct.
Technology Policy	Students should bring their MCS chromebooks and chargers to class each day. Teachers monitor student activity and participation; however, students are responsible for their activity on school-issued devices and using their MCS accounts. Cell phones and earbuds/headphones will not be allowed to be used during classroom instruction time. Phones and earbuds/headphones will be put away in a location designated by the teacher and placed in silent mode. Students will have access to their phones and earbuds/headphones outside of classroom instruction time, such as between classes and during lunch, but devices should be put away when students are in the serving line. Failure to follow these procedures will result in a disciplinary referral to the office.

Grading Policy	60% = Assessments (Tests, Essays, Projects)

(MCS Policy)	40% = Daily Grades (Quizzes, Homework, Classwork, and Participation)
Late Work Policy	Late work can be submitted for full credit until the semester grading period ends. Students may work on late work in class or at home. After the semester ends and grades are finalized, no late work can be accepted. Before a student submits late work, a zero will be placed in the gradebook.
Homework	Homework is not assigned in advanced art unless a student falls behind on a project. In that case, they may take the project home to complete and return it to Ms. Smith for grading.
