Unit i*	Vocabulary: weather, places/landmarks in the city, sequence of events Grammar: the verb <i>faire</i> with weather, past tense with <i>avoir</i> and <i>être</i> , irregular adjectives Culture and Geography: sites and monuments in Paris, Haiti, the métro
Unit 1	Vocabulary: holidays, TV genres and opinions Grammar: regular verbs, possessive adjectives, demonstrative adjectives, verbs <i>avoir</i> and <i>être</i> , indefinite articles Culture and Geography: city of Québec, francophone holidays, Luxembourg, French reality TV
Unit 2	Vocabulary: describing art, giving directions, places around town, transportation Grammar: past tense, present tense of irregular verbs, superlatives Culture and Geography: museums and neighborhoods in Paris, the RER, palace of Versailles
Unit 3	Vocabulary: daily routine, chores, relationships Grammar: reflexive verbs in present, past, and imperative; irregular plurals Culture and Geography: Cameroon, Ivory Coast, Senegal, immigration
Unit 4	Vocabulary: farm animals, countryside, professions Grammar: imperfect tense, expressions of time, the verb <i>croire</i> , imperfect and preterite together Culture and Geography: French agriculture and rural life, Montmartre and Toulouse-Lautrec
Unit 5	Vocabulary: parts of the body, healthy and unhealthy habits, illness and injury Grammar: reflexive verbs, imperfect for making suggestions, conditional tense Culture and Geography: Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, raï music, souks
Unit 6	Vocabulary: air travel, car travel, at the hotel Grammar: object pronouns, forms of <i>tout</i> , verbs <i>conduire</i> and <i>boire</i> Culture and Geography: Air France, Bordeaux, driving in France, French hotels
Unit 7*	Vocabulary: restaurant menus, regions of France, local travel Grammar: relative pronouns, the pronoun <i>en</i> , interrogative pronouns, stress pronouns Culture and Geography: Alsace (Strasbourg), Normandy (Rouen), Brittany (Saint-Malo), youth hostels
Unit 8*	Vocabulary: at the beach, camping, global travel Grammar: adverbs, comparative and superlative of adverbs, the verb <i>dormir</i> Culture and Geography: French Riviera (Nice), art museums, Alps (Grenoble), camping in France, French Guiana
