### December Challenge:

### Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: blending and segmenting onset and rime (/h/-/op/ or /j/-/et/)

Phonics: identifying and writing letter Ll, Rr, and Oo and their sounds (short vowel o)

Sight Words: are, little, with

Vocabulary Words: grain, provides, polluted, replace, save, less, recycle, base

Comprehension: Ask and answer questions about unfamiliar words in text

### Math: Big Ideas Chapter 6 - Add Numbers Within 10

Students will tell how many objects there are to start, how many objects are added to a group, and how many objects there are in all.

Students will tell what a plus and equal sign mean and explain an addition sentence.

Students will write an addition sentence.

Students will write an addition sentence using partner numbers.
