

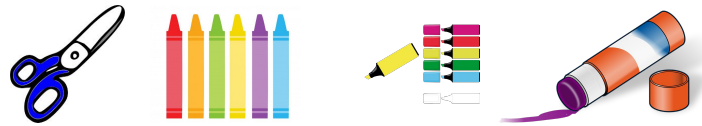

Reading:

Sight Words: who, what, where, and an

Vocabulary Words: humid, moist, weather, tools, information, measure, predict, temperature, Earth, occur

Read Alouds: Hail: Ice from the Sky and Weather Measures

Comprehension: Describe the relationship between texts and illustrations

Math: Big Ideas Chapter
