This group will meet <u>twice a month on Thursdays from 7:10 a.m.-7:40 a.m.</u> and will occasionally need to be available before or after school as needed.

So, how do you apply? First, make sure you meet these requirements and are willing to accept these duties:

Requirements for Membership:

- 1. Members must <u>maintain at least a C average and no failing grades in any classes</u> at the nine week report cards.
- 2. Members must have <u>no disciplinary referrals</u> during the school year.
 - a. This includes in-school suspension (ISS), out of school suspension (OSS), or alternative school
- 3. Members must care about and represent Columbia Elementary School and eS2S as well.
- 4. Members must be willing to make a yearlong commitment to eS2S.
- 5. Members must be available to attend eS2S meetings and functions

Membership Duties:

- 1. Students will be "campus scouts". This includes keeping our campus clean by putting things back where they belong and picking up any trash in or around the school grounds.
- 2. 5th grade members will participate in the morning announcements by leading the pledge of allegiance.
- 3. Members of eS2S will serve as spokespeople, ambassadors, and tour guides throughout the school year whenever a new student enrolls. (This will involve missing class sometimes, and the <u>student being responsible for making up any missed schoolwork</u>.)
- 4. We will dedicate some of our morning meetings to create goodie bags to give to new students as they enroll throughout the school year.
- 5. Members will assist the PTA with various meetings and/or events.
- 6. Students may help with car line, support teachers, and/or assist in the media center.
- 7. Students will assist in preparation for any school-wide event that may take place this school year.
- 8. Members will participate in leadership trainings and attend meetings.
- 9. Students will train incoming ambassadors.
