2023-2024 Competition Dance Clinic and Tryouts

Who: Any upcoming 7th or 8th grader who will attend Journey Middle School during the 2024-2025 school year and is interested in being a part of the dance team.

When: Clinic: March 19th-20th, 3:30-5:30 Closed Tryout: March 21st, 3:30-4:30

Where: JMS SLC Area (We will meet in the cafeteria and walk there together on the first day).

Attire: <u>Clinic Days</u>: tank top, athletic shorts, and jazz shoes (or flexible tennis shoes) <u>Tryout (Thursday)</u>: White tank top, black shorts, jazz shoes (or flexible tennis shoes), no jewelry, hair pulled out of face

To participate in the clinic and tryouts, each dancer candidate must have the following forms filled out in their entirety by March 19th.

- 1. Sign up for Tryouts via the Google Form (Scan the QR Code below or visit the link on our page of the JMS website)
- 2. Sign up for our team on Dragonfly Max
 - a. Go to dragonflymax.com. Log in to your account or sign up for free. Enter your name and email address, and enter code A84BAG to join JMS. Select your sport (Dance) and enter the following information:
 - i. Updated medical & demographic information for 2024-2025
 - ii. Preparticipation Physical Evaluation Form
- 3. Complete two Teacher Recommendation Forms. These will be sent from the coaches directly to teachers when candidates complete the Google Form. Candidates should ask teachers before attaching their names to the Google Form.

All forms should be complete by March 19th. Failure to do so will result in a candidate being deemed ineligible for tryouts.

Required Skills

*Each of these skills will be covered at the clinic. Do not worry if they are new to you!

Left Split Leap Right Split Leap Single Pirouette Double Pirouette High Kicks (left and right/front and diagonal) Fan kick Splits (left or right - must attempt)

Dance Routine

On clinic days, Coach Day will teach you a short dance routine that you will perform at tryouts. Below are the specific categories that you will be evaluated on in your performance:

- 1. Stage presence
- 2. Technique
- 3. Memory
- 4. Rhythm/Movement
- 5. Overall Impression

Requirements for 2024-2025 Dance Team

Students/Parents & Guardians,

Please read the following requirements carefully. Failure to meet the needs could result in suspension or dismissal from the squad.

- 1. All dance candidates must be physically able to try out.
- 2. All dance candidates must turn in all required forms and paperwork in Dragonfly by March 19th, 2023.
- 3. All dancers must be a Journey Middle School student entering either the 7th or 8th grade for the 2024-2025 school year.
- 4. All dancers must maintain a 70 overall average in each subject area. This average must be kept in all classes in order to remain an active dance team member.
- 5. All dancers must be able to attend at least one clinic day before tryouts. We recommend attending both days to feel the most confident and prepared for tryouts.
- 6. All dancers must attend all summer practices and meetings, including UDA Camp (June 11-14).
- 7. All dancers must attend all chosen JMS football and basketball games and compete in local and regional competitions.
- 8. Dancers must attend all in-season practices unless a parent notice and valid excuse have been given in advance. All practices two weeks before a competition are mandatory.
- 9. Dancers must abide by the Journey Middle School Student-Athlete Contract (can be found on the JMS website under Athletic Forms)
- 10. Dancers must agree to abide by the 2024-2025 Spirit Team Demerit System. Dancers must understand that the accumulation of too many demerits can result in dismissal from the team.
- 11. Parents of dancers must accept all monetary obligations.
- 12. Parents of dancers must be willing to work a designated number of times in the JMS Concession Stand.
- 13. Parents of dancers must be willing to participate in a carpool to/from games, competitions, and camp.
