- Remain in good standing with their current and valid Alabama Teaching Certificate.
- Grade students work within 48 hours with quality feedback.
- Respond to communication in a timely manner, no more than 48 hours.
- Work with Administrators, Counselors, Facilitators and Students to ensure student success.
- Teachers work with students with IEP/ELL/504 plans to accommodate based on their accommodations.
- Teachers are required to attend a Monthly Faculty Meeting to stay up to date with current ALSDE ACCESS Policies. They receive 2 CEUs for attendance.
- Teachers provide enrichment learning opportunities in the form of videos, tutoring sessions, study guides, and extra resource materials.
