Adobe Creative Cloud	A suite of creative tools like Photoshop, Illustrator, and Premiere Pro, used by students for digital design, video editing, and other multimedia projects.
BreakoutEDU	A game-based learning platform that promotes collaboration and problem-solving through immersive challenges similar to escape rooms, used to engage students in critical thinking across subjects.
Canva	A graphic design tool that allows students and teachers to create presentations, posters, and other visual content, enhancing creativity and visual learning in the classroom.
ChessKid	An online platform that teaches students chess through lessons, puzzles, and live games, helping them develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and strategy skills.
Clever	A secure portal that gives students and teachers easy, one-stop access to all of their digital learning tools and resources using a single login.
Code.org	A platform that teaches students computer science and coding basics through fun, interactive lessons and activities, helping them develop problem-solving and programming skills in the classroom.
DeltaMath	An online platform that provides math practice and instructional videos, allowing students to strengthen their math skills through interactive exercises.
Edgenuity	An online learning program providing customizable courses in core subjects and electives, often used for credit recovery, blended learning, or supplemental instruction.
Ellevation	A tool designed to support English Language Learners (ELLs) by helping teachers monitor student progress, set learning goals, and provide tailored instructional support.
GoGuardian	A tool that helps teachers monitor and manage student devices during online learning to ensure students stay focused on their educational tasks while using technology.
Google Workspace	A collection of productivity tools like Google Docs, Slides, and Drive that support collaboration, communication, and organization for students and teachers.
iLit	A personalized literacy program that provides interactive lessons, activities, and a digital library to support reading and writing development while allowing teachers to track student progress.
i-Ready	A comprehensive assessment and instruction program that personalizes learning for students in reading and math, helping to identify areas for growth and monitor progress.
IXL	A personalized learning platform that offers comprehensive practice in math, language arts, science, and social studies, helping students improve through adaptive questions.
Kami	A digital tool for annotating PDFs and documents, allowing students to interact with their assignments by highlighting, adding text, and drawing directly on files.

Seesaw	A digital portfolio platform that allows students to share their learning through pictures, videos, and drawings, giving parents a window into their child's progress.
STEMscopes	A science curriculum resource that provides hands-on activities and digital lessons aligned with standards to help students explore STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) concepts.
TalkingPoints	A communication app that allows teachers and parents to stay connected through text messages, offering multilingual support to break down language barriers.
