HEALS is an organization that utilizes doctors and nurses to help kids in schools get access to a doctor. HEALS functions as the primary health care provider for its patients and are able to treat and resolve students' health problems by referring out to specialists if necessary. The doctors donate their time and resources in order to help kids throughout the Madison City school system. HEALS just opened a new mobile clinic for Madison City Schools. This bus moves around from school to school and provides children with healthcare opportunities. They can provide routine checkups, dental care, and more.

Who can utilize HEALS?

HEALS, as an organization, was created for kids. Their primary focus is only students registered at a school. Students without insurance, Medicaid and AllKids at our partnering schools and their siblings are eligible to become HEALS patients. Parents of these children should contact HEALS and fill out the appropriate paperwork. You can find enrollment information on the HEALS website within the QR code below. Parents can also speak to their school nurse to learn more about enrollment. Students have to obtain signed parental consent before using services provided by HEALS. Students receive the same level of care as a full-service pediatrician's office.
