- Students must come in person for all tests
- If students require help, they must come on campus at BJHS
- **There will be no refunds for any classes for any reason**
- In-person classes are held in BJHS E-wing (NW corner of building near Eastview Dr)

 <u>BREAKFAST/LUNCH IS PROVIDED</u>
- Sign-ups will take place from <u>May 1-May 23.</u>

DRIVERS EDUCATION:

- Students are required to come the first day of class for a full day (8am-3pm)
- If they do not come, they fail the course
- Driving days will be scheduled and students
 must come on that day

ACCESS:

- All Credit Recovery/Advancement courses are taken through ACCESS (except Drivers Ed and ACT Bootcamp)
- Content for ACCESS courses is structured for completion in either a traditional year-long (1.0 credit) or semester-long (0.5 credit) format
- Completing ACCESS courses over the summer will require diligence and an accelerated pace
- Fully online course/curriculum
- Teachers are fully online
- Tests must be taken in-person and proctored at Bob Jones High School
- There will be three in-person tutors/facilitators at Bob Jones High School
 - If a student needs help, they must come in person to BJHS to meet with the tutors
 - Available 8am-12pm (Mon-Thurs)
- If students are not making adequate progress, <u>ACCESS WILL DROP THE STUDENT and NO</u> <u>refund will be issued</u>.
