# COMPLETION CHECKLIST

- Complete registration form and have a parent sign
- Enter course requests & alternates in Powerschool Portal (instructions on back)
- Attach any required forms (with signatures) to registration form
  - Credit Evaluation signed by student & parent (rising SENIORS only)
  - AP Agreement form (optional)
  - Mid-Year Completion form (optional)
  - Dual Enrollment form (optional)
- Return completed registration form to your 2nd block teacher

## **RISING 12TH GRADERS**

- Use the credit evaluation from your counselor to request remaining requirements for graduation
- College applications typically become available to complete in August or September of senior year
- Send official transcripts to colleges through our website (madisoncityal.scriborder.com)
- Scholarship deadlines are typically between November and February of senior year
- Local scholarship deadlines are typically in the spring of your senior year
- DO NOT use CommonApp without speaking to Dr.
   Bostick about it first Those electing to do so will not need to complete it until August 1st
- Dr. Bostick will hold a parent & student meeting February 21st at 5:30pm in Patriot Hall to prepare rising 12th graders for senior year
- List Dr. Bostick as the counselor on ALL applications and recommendations for college

# SUMMER SCHOOL INFO

- There will be a separate registration process for summer school. More details should be out by April. Check the BJHS website under "Registration" -> "Summer School"
- Classes typically offered for advancement:
   Beginning Kinesiology, Drivers Education, Career
   Prep, Health, US Government, & Economics

# CO-OP / WORK-BASED EDUCATION

- Ilth and 12th grade students may participate in Co-Op if employed or participating in an internship and have transportation to leave from/arrive to campus
- For each block of Co-Op per semester, 140 hours of verifiable work/internship must be logged that semester
- Co-Op blocks must be scheduled at the beginning or end of the school day (1st block, 4th block, 1st & 2nd, or 3rd & 4th)

# **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

**REQUIREMENTS:** 

- Meet the school's minimum GPA Requirement
- Ability to pay tuition at participating college/university
- Meet prerequisites for desired courses through qualifying ACT scores, placement tests, and/or AP scores
- Visit the dual enrollment page on the BJHS website for more information

# OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS

- Scheduling errors made by the school will be corrected (repeating a course, courses out of sequence, etc.)
- Requests must account for 8 blocks (4 fall and 4 spring). There are no options for a "free block" or "off-block"
- Scheduled off-blocks are ONLY for Co-Op, dual enrollment, virtual classes, or a 5th block athletic PE.
- All students should provide <u>at least three</u> alternate courses. Creating schedules can become tricky, and alternate courses are often necessary
