Eligibility

- Rising 11th & 12th Graders ONLY
- High school counselor must verify student's ability to complete graduation requirements while in ACT*:
 - Rising 11th planning to take ACT for two years:
 - By end of 10th grade, must earn minimum of 13.0 credits, including EITHER:
 - o 7.0 core classes + Career Prep, Health, & PE
 - 8.0 core classes + Health & EITHER Career Prep OR PE
 - Rising 12th planning to take ACT for one year:
 - By end of 11th grade, must earn a minimum of 21.0 credits, including:
 - o 13.0 core classes + Career Prep, Health, and PE

*If requirements are not met, Summer School may be required to ensure student is eligible to take ACT and remain on track for graduation

Application Process

- Application deadline: January 31, 2025
- Interviews held in February 2025
- Determinations made by early March
