SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION (Form 2025A)

PLEASE NOTE: Only high school seniors and previous winners in their first year of college are eligible to receive FAITH Initiative scholarships.

Thank you for taking time to apply for a Fellowship Advocacy Inspiring Transformation and Hope Initiative (F.A.I.T.H. INITIATIVE) Scholarship. To complete this application you must:

- 1. Send with this completed application a one-page typed essay or theme telling why you are applying for the scholarship. In approximately ³/₄ of the essay, write about any financial hardships you need to overcome in order to attend college. In the other ¹/₄ of the essay, explain your educational and career goals. Only completed application packages will be considered.
 - 2. Send, or have sent, to the F.A.I.T.H. Initiative Scholarship Program a certified transcript that arrives in a sealed envelope. It may be included in your scholarship package.
 - 3. Ask two individuals to send letters of recommendation for the scholarship applicant. At least one of these persons *must be* a current teacher or school official.
 - 4. Send a photo, preferably in cap and gown (Do not send a casual cell-phone photo.)
 - 5. Include proof of enrollment or acceptance as a full-time student to an accredited community college, university, or technical school.

Application, letters, transcript, personal photograph, and proof of enrollment to a higher institution of learning (all of the above) should be sent to the following address: F.A.I.T.H. Initiative Scholarship Program, P.O. Box 3858, Huntsville, Alabama 35810. The deadline for receiving *all* application materials is *on* March 1, 2025, received at the PO address above.

Purpose

The purpose of the F.A.I.T.H. Scholarship Awards is to provide scholarships to students who are pursuing higher learning at an accredited institution, a community college, or a technical school and who demonstrate potential to become productive members of the community. Scholarship awards are *limited to undergraduate studies* for students residing in the Tennessee Valley (Huntsville/Madison County, Decatur/Morgan County and Athens/Limestone County, Alabama) area. However, recipients are *not limited* to enrollment or acceptance in an institution of higher learning *in Alabama* to receive a scholarship.

Awards

Several undergraduate scholarship awards are available annually. Awards are for one year only, but *recipients may re-apply for a second year*. (The FAITH Board of Directors reserves the option of how many awards are given.)

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be accepted as a full-time undergraduate student attending an accredited community college, university, or technical school by early spring of the year awarded;
 - 2. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or better on a grading scale of 4.0;
 - 3. Applicant must explain his or her financial hardship in an essay;
 - 4. Applicant must provide evidence of public service as a volunteer and include number of hours volunteered last year;
- 5. Applicant *must attend school* and reside in these Alabama counties: Huntsville/Madison County; Decatur/Morgan County; Athens/Limestone County.
 - 6. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.

F.A.I.T.H. Initiative scholarships are awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, national origin, or sexual orientation. The F.A.I.T.H. Initiative will not award scholarships to applicants who do not meet eligibility requirements and whose application package is incomplete. The Organization reserves the right *not* to award a scholarship in a given year. The Organization also reserves the right to award scholarships to students of an under-represented minority.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Minimum required cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better;
- 2. Two letters of recommendation--(At least one of these individuals *must* be a current teacher or school official);
- 3. A one-page typed essay or theme telling why you are applying for the scholarship. In approximately 1/3 of the essay, write about any financial hardships you need to overcome in order to attend college; in another 1/3, explain your educational and career goals; and in the remaining space, explain why you are motivated to volunteer time to your community.
 - 4. Summary of volunteer experiences; and
 - 5. A *complete* application package.

Note: It is not necessary to send these explanatory pages with the application form below when you apply.
