

On-Site/Hybrid Instructional Models

Offered for PreKindergarten through 12th grade students.

Goals:

- ~Allow for on-site instruction while providing a safe learning environment for **all** students and staff.
- ~Maintain a small cohort size to ensure all safety protocols are followed and to ensure student management within those safety protocols is possible.
- ~Provide ability to maintain 6 feet distance while still being able to teach & support learners.

7th Grade

9th & 10th Grade Combined w/separate homeroom locations

11th & 12th Grade Combined w/separate homeroom locations

~All Grade Levels will be assigned a homeroom classroom. They will attend classes in their homeroom as much as possible.

~7th & 8th Grade Cohorts will be self-contained with two CORE teachers to minimize exposure risk.

~All Cohorts attend school Monday-Thursday on a full day 7-period schedule from 8:12am-3:47pm.
