| 30 min    | Presentations of curriculum materials for the District's instruction relating to the prevention of child abuse, family violence, dating violence, and sex trafficking. | Patty McAlpin, counselor at Colt Elementary, and Rebecca Taylor, Counselor at Marble Falls Middle School, presented the recommendation from the MFISD K-8 subgroup that met and reviewed materials.<br><br>The recommended K-8 materials are: Play it Safe. Ms. Taylor discussed the benefits of the use of a curriculum like Play it Safe. They recommended working with the Children's Advocacy Center. Ms. McAlpin reviewed the topics in the materials, and the committee watched trailers from some of the videos included in the materials. |

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|        |   | <p>Mrs. Leflet shared some Burnet County statistics for child abuse and also how the parents would “opt in” to their children participating in the program. She also shared that the groups that reviewed materials all agreed on Play it Safe.</p> <p>SHAC member asked about training for staff to recognize child abuse, and Mrs. Leflet shared that all staff receive that training yearly both online and in person.</p> <p>Committee voted to approve moving forward by consensus with Play it Safe for K-8.</p> <p>Mrs. Leflet reviewed the recommendation for high school students called Not a Number. She mentioned that parents would also have to “opt in”. She showed the introductory video and passed out a form with information about the modules in the program. She shared that she visited with another district that used the program and is satisfied with the program and that the committee that reviewed the materials was in consensus to use the materials Not a Number.</p> <p>No committee members had any questions. Committee was in consensus to recommend Not a Number for high school students.</p> |
