Directions: You must complete the following components.

- 1. Read ANTHEM, a novella by Ayn Rand.
- 2. Annotate the entire novel in a manner that enhances your understanding. If you purchase your own book you can annotate directly in the novel. Please use sticky notes, or a real/digital notebook if you borrowed a book from the school. Possible notations include:
 - a. Plot structure and development
 - Conflicts, internal and external
 - ii. Foreshadowing, etc.
 - b. Tone
 - c. Characterization (direct and indirect)
 - d. Devices
 - i. Imagery
 - ii. Symbols
 - iii. Word choice (diction)
 - iv. Sentence structure (syntax)
 - e. Theme
- After reading the novel, <u>create 3 essential questions</u> that you feel Rand wants her readers to consider or answer in response to her novel, and notate passages that prompted the questions.
- 4. <u>In the second week of class, there will be a reading check quiz on *ANTHEM*, and you will write short answer responses.</u>
