Purpose and Charge

- Consider the educational needs of all students and align with the district's mission, vision and goals.
- Represent the entire community, its values and perceptions in the facility planning process.
- Assess and prioritize the district's current and long-term facility needs, including, but not limited to:
 - Building age, safety and condition
 - District growth and capacity
 - Evolving educational delivery and programs
- Potentially bring forward recommendations to the Board of Trustees as to how to proceed with a long-range plan.

Committee Process

In the upcoming meetings, the committee will discuss the following topics:

- Existing Facility Conditions
- Facility and Equipment Needs
- School Finance
- Potential Solutions & Cost Analysis
- Community Survey
- District staff members and district consultants will aid the committee and serve as information providers.
- Will be led by chairperson(s).




Our Schools

Our Schools


- HEB Excellence in Education, Fine Arts, Athletics, Academics, Operations
