Scholarship History:

The scholarship was established in 2005 in memory of Joshua L. Bailey. Joshua had a true passion for education and always dreamt of being a history teacher. He was diligent throughout his education while rising above his severe learning disability. He never viewed his disability as a hindrance; he chose to accept it. Joshua was already a teacher and took every opportunity to teach others. He used his many life experiences such as his disability, his Eagle Scout Project, and the time he served with the Army Military Police in Baghdad as teaching opportunities.

Joshua originally established the funding for this scholarship in his will. After his death in 2004, the scholarship committee put his wishes into action. Current funding comes from what the Joshua L. Bailey Education Foundation raises each year. The Big Bigby Bolt 5K is the annual fundraiser held in September of each year.

Eligibility/Application requirements:

- 1. Graduating senior of a high school in Maury County
- 2. Two letters of recommendation (one must be from a teacher)
- 3. High school Transcript
- 4. Completed Application with essay

Application Process:
