The Scholarship Criteria for the Lance Cpl. Andrew P. Carpenter Memorial Honor Scholarship

Purpose: The Andrew P. Carpenter Memorial Honor Scholarship awards an annual Scholarship to a Maury County Public School senior going to college based on academic achievement and financial need.

Criteria: The students applying for the scholarships must have an intent to continue their education at a two or four-year college or university or a trade school. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need and the student's essay response. Applicants are to submit the scholarship application on the form provided by the Andrew P. Carpenter Detachment #1286 of the Marine Corps League.

Proof of GPA may be a report card or official transcript but either must be signed and dated by a school administrator.

<u>Deadline</u>: The application deadline is April 15, 2024. No applications will be accepted after this date.

Award Date: June 18, 2024 at the Scholarship Awards Ceremony.

Guidelines: Scholarship amounts will depend on FUNDS AVAILABLE.

The \$1000 scholarship will be distributed in equal payment in August and December in the year the Scholarship is awarded. Students must continue to attend classes and maintain a 2.5 CPA or equivalent. He/She must show proof of class attendance and GPA, in December in the year awarded the scholarship, or no Funds will be provided in the following Quarter or Semester. Instruction will be given to the students after the awards ceremony on how the funds will be paid out and to whom.
