## Ellen Davies Rodgers/Zachariah Davies Scholarship

Dear Regents and Chapter Scholarship Chairs:

**Ellen Davies Rodgers/Zachariah Davies Scholarship:** a \$750 scholarship granted to a graduating senior, who will be attending an accredited 4-year U.S. college or university granting a degree. A 300-500 word essay is required as well as a narrative of his/her patriotic endeavors, plus transcripts, resume, and three letters of recommendation from an educator, C.A.R. senior leader, employer, minister, or youth activity leader. Use the EDR/ZD Scholarship Application found on the following page.

**During August and September,** please send information to Tennessee students (public, private, or home schooled) and to college/guidance counselors about the EDR/ZD Scholarship awarded to a high school senior who plans to attend an accredited 4-year U.S. college and university granting a degree.

Include a cover letter when you provide the scholarship applications to the counselors at each school or to individual students. Copy the description given below which provides a concise overview of the scholarship.

**Note:** Applicants must be sponsored by a DAR Chapter.  
Applicants must be U.S. citizens and Tennessee residents.  
Deadlines must be observed.

Please use the following checklist for successful completion of the application process.

- **Applications must be postmarked to the Chapter Chair on or before October 22.**
- **Applications must be postmarked to the State Chair on or before November 5.**
- **All required information must be submitted as one package.** Each applicant must provide **two copies** of each application. Please, NO PHOTOS with applications.
- Chapters may sponsor only three applications for the EDR/ZD Scholarship. If you have more than three applicants, choose the best three to submit. Include a brief cover letter for each applicant your chapter sponsors, signed by the Chapter Chair or the Chapter Regent.
- Copy the application form and instructions to give to the counselors or directly to the students. **Fill out the chapter contact information** before giving out the application.

The Ellen Davies Rodgers/Zachariah Davies Scholarship Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen and a current resident of Tennessee who will be entering his/her freshman year in an accredited 4-year college or university granting a degree. Each applicant is requested to write an essay of 300-500 words, double-spaced, entitled: **"My Future and How I Hope to Achieve My Goal,"** as well as a narrative of **"My Patriotic Endeavors."** This narrative does not have a word limit.

**The application must be postmarked on or before October 22.**

Please submit two copies of the application with all supporting documentation to the sponsoring chapter scholarship chair. The following information is to be assembled by the student, working with the college or guidance counselor at the applicant's high school.

**Cover Sheet:**

- Name of Scholarship
- Student's name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address.
- College or guidance counselor's name
- High School name and address
- Sponsoring DAR Chapter name, name and e-mail address of Scholarship Chair or Chapter Regent

**A copy of this application page**

- Narrative:** "My Patriotic Endeavors." (double-spaced, no word limit)
- Essay:** "My Future and How I Hope to Achieve My Goal" (300-500 words, double-spaced.)
- Colleges/Universities** with addresses to which student has applied
- Birth Certificate** (a copy)
- Official transcripts** showing grades for seven semesters (if possible), class rank, ACT and/or SAT scores
- Resume** including school, church, community activities, employment, awards, etc .
- Community Information:** Three letters of recommendation from an educator, employer, minister, youth activity leader, or C.A.R Senior leader (only one from a field)
