Raise your hand to be acknowledged. Be respectful of others when they are speaking.

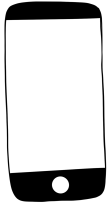
### GROUP WORK

## HOMEWORK POLICY :

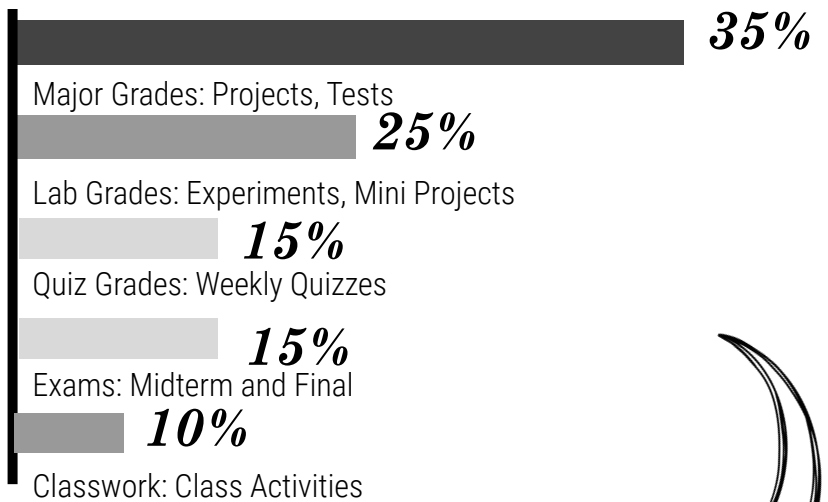

## AP TEST

The student will have an opportunity to take the AP test on May 9, 2024. The cost of the exam is \$95 and will be due in October. You can score a range of 1-5 on the exam. Depending on your score and your chosen university, you may receive a general science college credit (typically sophomore level) from the APES course.

## AP CLASSROOM/TEAMS

We will work in AP Classroom often. It is important to use this resource and stay on top of assignments in AP Classroom. We will also work in an online notebook in TEAMS. You must check TEAMS daily.
