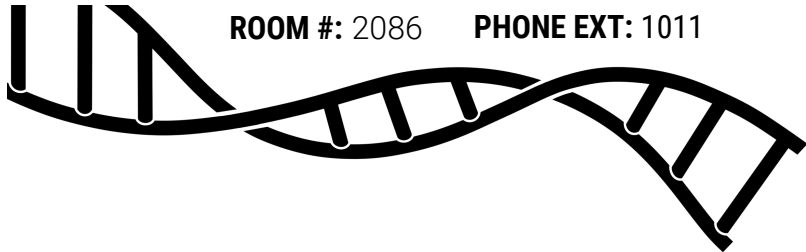

Raise your hand to be acknowledged. Be respectful of others when they are speaking.

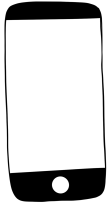
GROUP WORK

HOMEWORK POLICY :

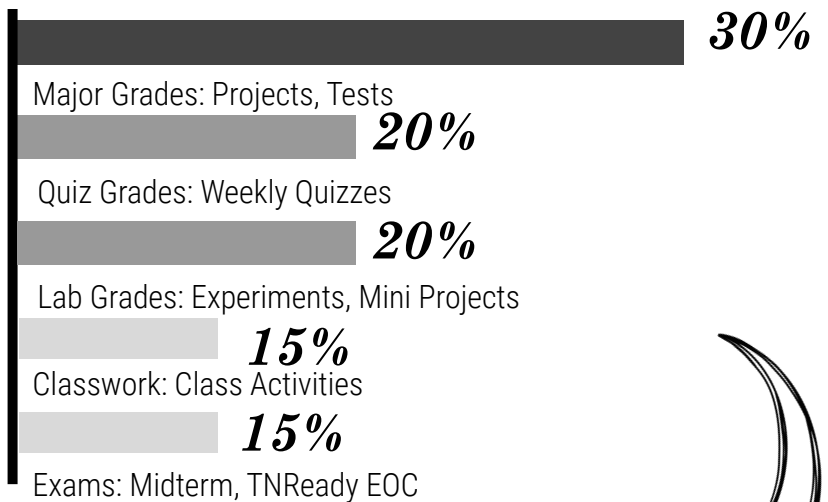
