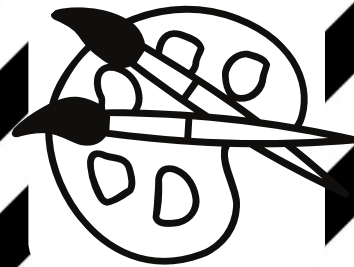

## What is Drawing II?

This course provides further exploration of drawing and painting foundations. Students explore the elements and principles of design through 2-Dimensional media including pencil, pen, oil pastels, watercolor, acrylic paint, and printing. This course will encompass art history, art criticism, aesthetics, and production pertaining to the Principles of Art. All this combined will lead to a portfolio with quality work.

## GRADES

### Projects - 30%

1 - 5 point system: Points will convert into a % grade based on the CHS grading scale.

### Sketchbooks - 25%

### Weekly Progress- 20%

## Due Dates
