One answer that I have seen is an early warning system that will alert staff so procedures can be put in place. Here are some samples that I have seen. They will monitor Attendance/Behavior/Academics.

Looking at Data


The data from the seven schools in Cohort I and the seven schools in Cohort II show areas that may need need a "deeper look".

The question I ponder is what data information are we using and what data is still needed to assist student growth? (Academically/Behaviorally)

That is a question we should ask the team at our school.

From the district view it seems Synergy houses this information. Every school level (Elementary/Middle/High) uses various programs to assess data on student academic performance/needs. The behavior information is coded in Synergy.
