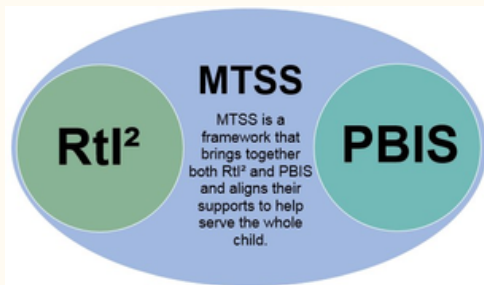


Bridge to Success: Student Support News

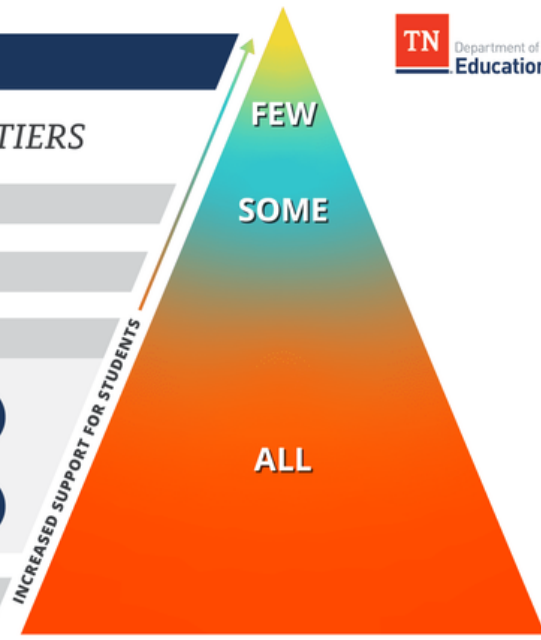
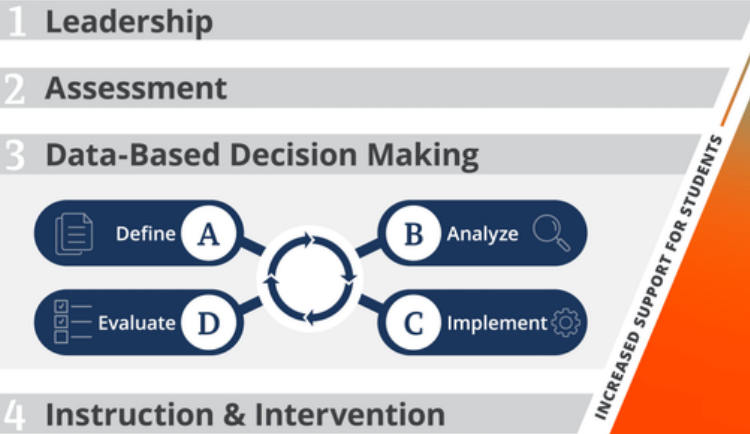

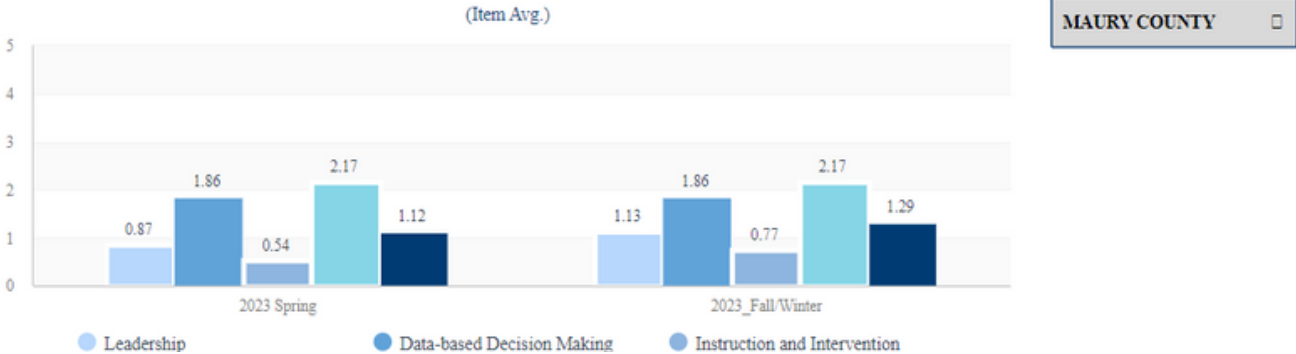
