

practices do you feel is important to continue in PD next year?




Overall Weighted Score: 1.53

I enjoyed this years PD. The Socio-Emotional PD was extremely helpful in navigating High School students. I would love to see more regarding Actively Learn


The special area teachers need more options that can connect to their programs.
