Transition planning begins at the early years and has the goal of learning... Who am I?



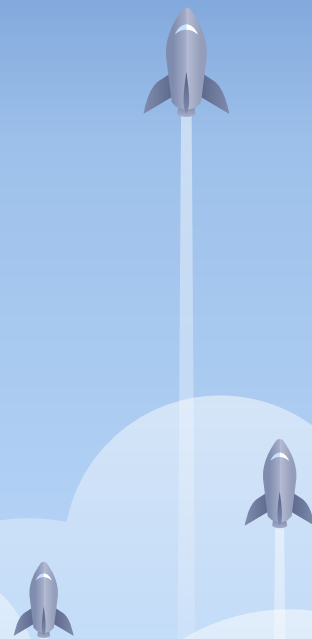


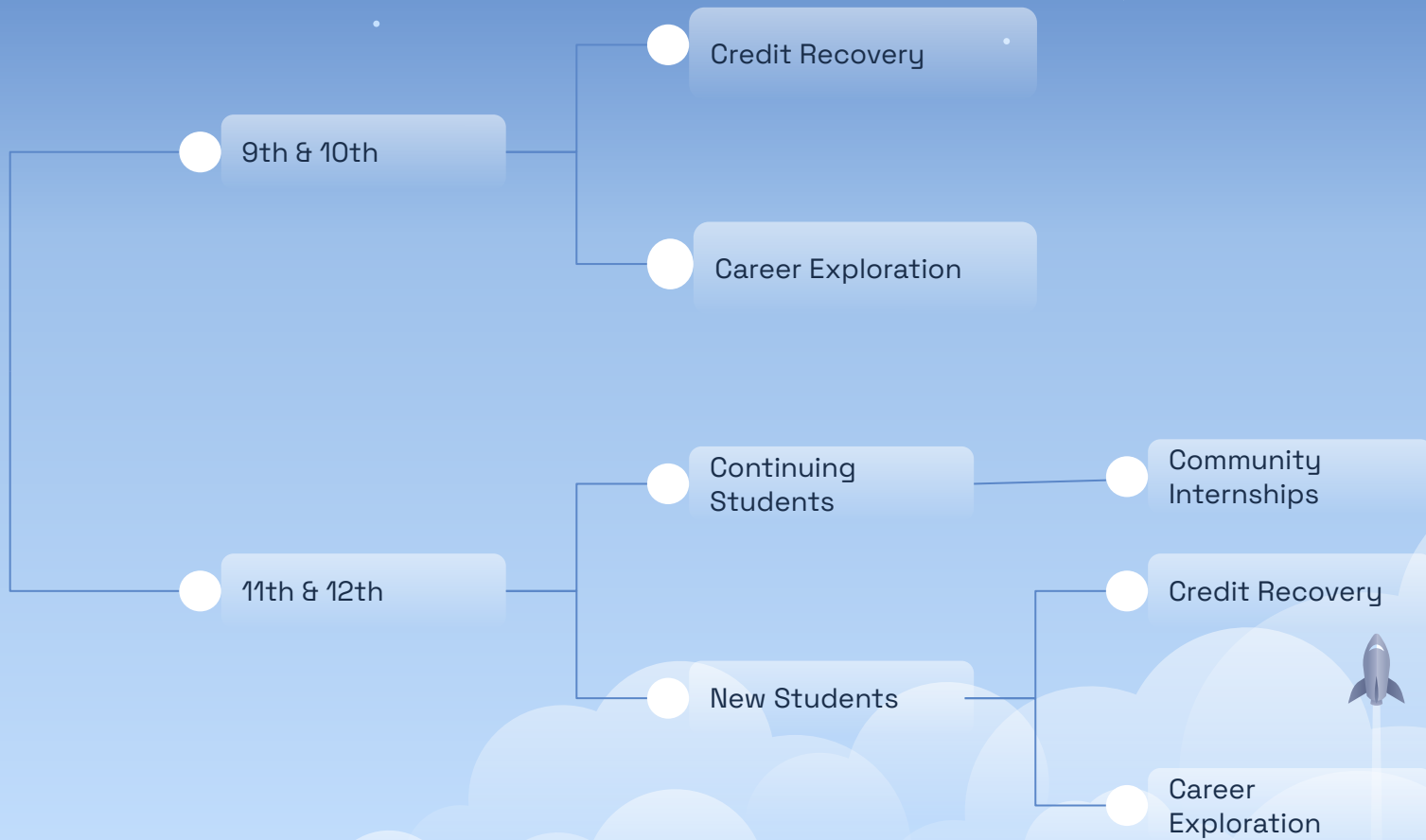
Mineola Alternative Program Reimagined

recovery to accelerated
career exploration and
opportunities

Students will have a **block schedule** for their major courses to provide them with **fewer transitions** and more time on task. This will enable them to recover any missing credits, and stay **on track** for graduation.

In addition, students will explore **career opportunities** during their freshman and sophomore years to enable them to participate in **internships** with community partners during their junior and senior years.

Let's review our strands

Computer Science

Providing the opportunity to have a head start in one of the fastest growing careers. Students involved in the CS strand earn college credits and participate in an internship experience in the field of computer science.

Healthcare

Our Healthcare program provides students an opportunity in senior year to take an introductory college course and explore career options including personal training and EKG technician.

Advanced Manufacturing

Manufacturing is a leading field on Long Island and growing. Students enrolled in the Manufacturing strand have the opportunity to earn college credits and visit local job sites and well as meet with industry leaders.

Registered Behavior Technician (RBT)

Prepare for employment in the field of education/psychology/ rehabilitation services. RBTs provide support and instruction to individuals with disabilities. Course includes behavior management, teaching strategies, and effective ways to support individuals with disabilities.

Entrepreneurship

Students enrolled in entrepreneurship will have an integral role in managing the school, MusBUYTangs. Responsibilities include creating and marketing inventory, managing the website and finances.
