# Adelphi High School Student Requirements:

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- ❑ High school **juniors and seniors** with strong academic records are eligible to participate in the High School Program.
  - ❑ Students may take up to **2 classes per semester**.
  - ❑ Families register for classes online at [academics.adelphi.edu/hsp](https://academics.adelphi.edu/hsp).
  - ❑ The current tuition is **\$315 per class**.
  - ❑ According to Adelphi, more than **90 percent** of the students who apply for college credit receive it at a variety of post secondary institutions across the country. *(Credit transfer practices vary by school. Students may receive elective credits, advanced standing, requirement waivers, or some combination of the above)*
