Adelphi High School Student Requirements:

- High school juniors and seniors with strong academic records are eligible to participate in the High School Program.
- ☐ Students may take up to **2 classes per semester**.
- ☐ Families register for classes online at <u>academics.adelphi.edu/hsp</u>.
- ☐ The current tuition is **\$315 per class**.
- According to Adelphi, more than **90 percent** of the students who apply for college credit receive it at a variety of post secondary institutions across the country. (Credit transfer practices vary by school. Students may receive elective credits, advanced standing, requirement waivers, or some combination of the above)
