Terminology

- Target growth
 - The typical “normed” growth for grade level children across the nation
 - Number is set in September and measured in the winter and Spring
- Percent meeting target growth
 - The number of children in the spring that meet or exceed the September target growth
 - This is calculated by teacher (APPR) and by grade

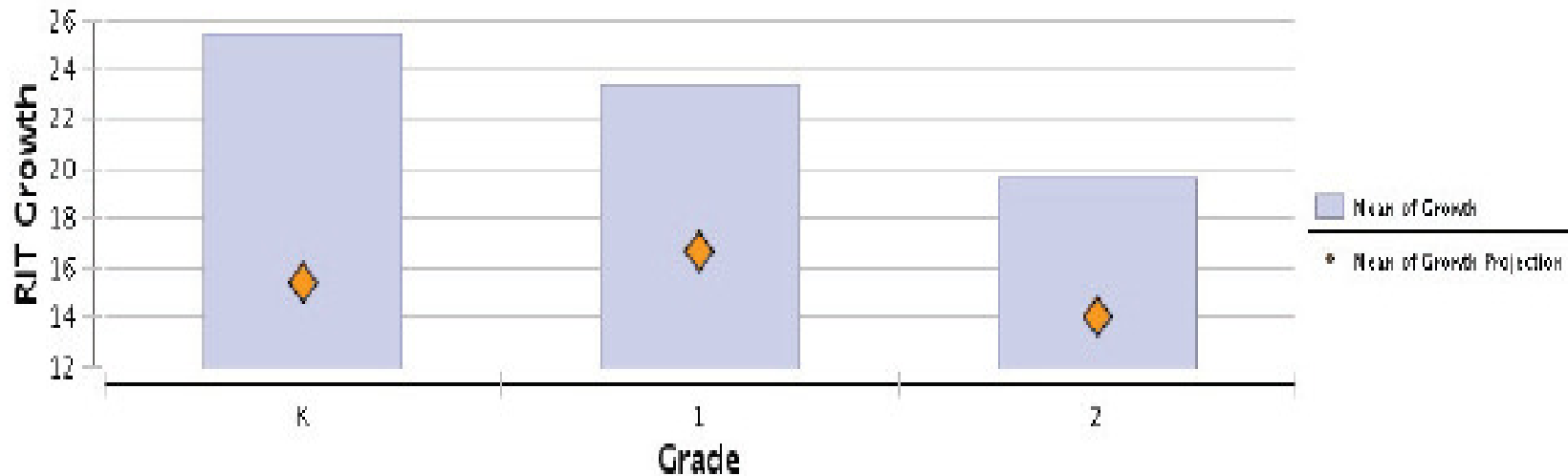

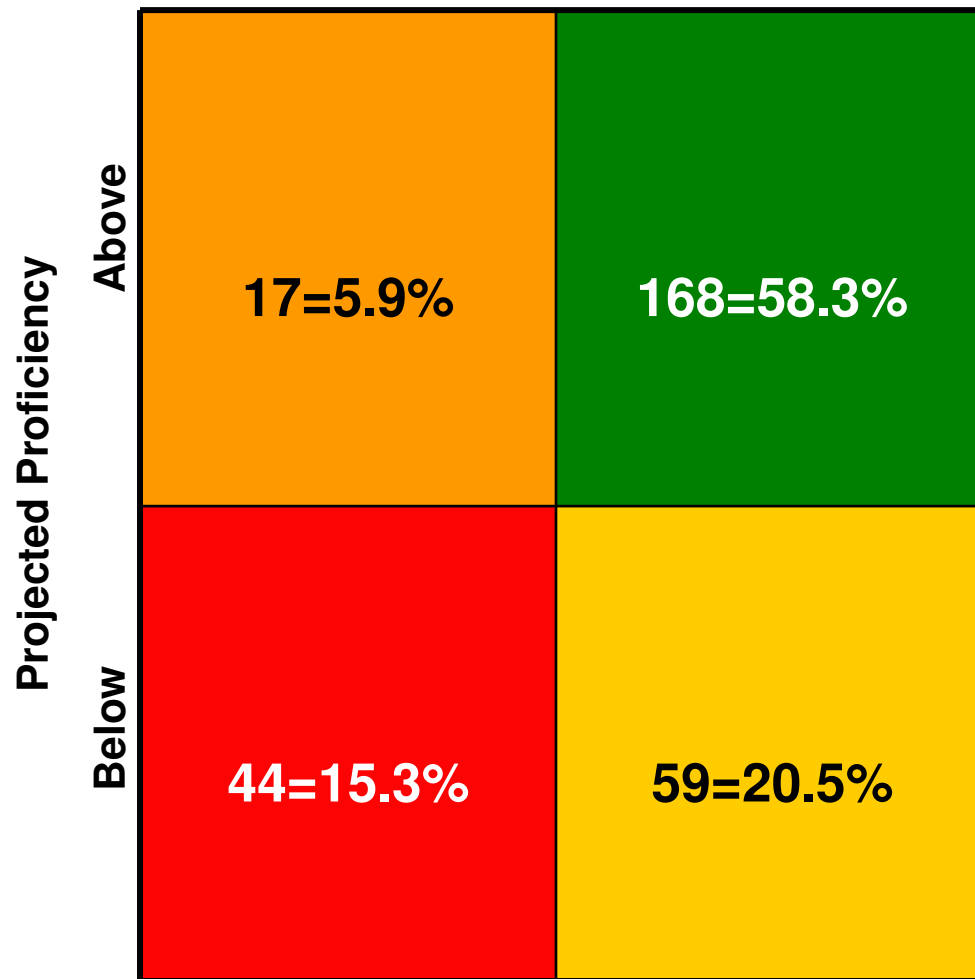
