Summary

- Cut score change by SED
 - 6 students did not pass, mastery dropped
- 5 new admits during school year
 - All failed first administration
- 25 students failed in January
 - Of those 21 retook the exam in June
 - Of those 12 passed, 3 more earned safety net
 - 10 students still outstanding
- Of the 206 students -188 received a grade of 65 or higher (91%)

Math Summary

- Integrated algebra
 - 8th grade alone = 92.5% passing rate
 - Low percent includes multiple failures by the same students. 14 students represent 55% of the failures
- Geometry
 - 253 students sat for the exam (9th and 10th grade)
- Algebra 2 and Trigonometry
 - Advanced regent diploma gateway
 - Half of the failures were seniors

ELA Next Steps

•The new Regents exam in English Language Arts (Common Core) consists of three parts, which include 24 multiple-choice items and two writing prompts.

•A major shift is a focus on evidence-based writing.

•Another shift requires students to read, analyze, and write from literary and informational texts.

•During the school year and the summer, our 8th and 9th grade teachers have had professional Development with Gina Castaldo to assist them in the transition to the new Common Core Learning Standard.

•Collaboration between the Literacy teacher and all departments in order to increase literacy and student achievement in all subject areas, including science, math social studies

•Common Assessments will be entered in the Cube so teachers have easy access to data; the assessments will be aligned to shared tests in format, content and length.

•The Professional Development and the assessments in the Cube will help:

- Analyze the interim assessment.
- Plan lessons to meet the rigor of that assessment.
- Allow the teacher to set the goal and monitor whether students reach their target.



Math next steps

- Thirteen students will be receiving individualized instruction during their lunch period every other day.
- The 8th graders who failed both the class and the Regents in 2012-13 will be taking Algebra A.
- Coordinate our efforts with ESL and Special Education using the Title Five funds allocated to the high school.
- Constant monitoring of students' progress, specifically the at-risk students.
- All repeaters will take the Regents based on the old standards.
- The 8th graders will take the Regents in Integrated Algebra test based on the Common Core in June 2014.
- Professional Development in new Common Core will be provided in 2013-2014.
