# Overall Goals

- Single Point Entry
  - Notification via camera or alarm if single point entry is compromised
  - Access doors- electronic access to school personnel from specific doors
- Electronic maps of all buildings that are accessible to school admin, security and first responders
  - Users can click on the camera icon on the map and then see that camera
- “Man traps”
  - Secure vestibules that require school personnel to allow entry into building
  - Desirable to have access to main office
- Panic Alarms
  - Wireless capability as well as hard wired at man trap
  - Automatically signals lockdown via PA system is pressed
  - Automatically signals Nassau County Police
- Command Center
  - One location in which the entire district can be viewed and monitored
    - In district at Willis Avenue
  - BOCES
    - Can use them for after hour or weekend monitoring or for police

# Security Vestibules- “Man Traps”

- High School- By June or summer
  - Move exterior glass wall South of the main entrance to create a new security area
  - Upgrade hardware on interior doors (4) to enable them to lock
  - Install buzzer system
  - Approximately \$17,000
- Middle School- Summer
  - Install new set of interior doors with lock and buzzer
  - Reconfigure main office to use existing security window
- Jackson Avenue- Summer
  - Reinforce second set of doors
  - Possibly reconfigure principal and main office to allow access to main office from the lobby
- Meadow Drive- Summer
  - Reconfigure Main office and Principal office to create a security window between the current set of doors
- Hampton Street- Summer/Fall (depends on design)
  - Most involved. Currently working with architects for best options
