Current

- We have 4 polling places:
 - Jackson
 - Meadow
 - Hampton
 - American Legion Hall (Cross)
 - Allowed us to use it last year without charge
- Each polling place has
 - Chief Election Inspector, Registrar, Inspectors



Costs associated with the election

Personnel:

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– 2011 $4,567
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- 2012 \$4,015 (introduced scanning pens for poll list)
- Machine rental
 - 2012 \$1,200- will increase to \$1,600 in 2013
- Machine transport
 - **-** 2012 \$1,200
- Ballots
 - 2012 \$ 300* new machines would be ~\$9,500
- Grand total for 2012 \$6,715
- Projected budget for 2013- \$7,115



Moving forward

- New Machines
 - Supplying 4 polling places will be very expensive
 - Storage
 - Cost of ballots
- American Legion as polling place
 - Availability in future
 - WiFi /network issues
- Personnel
 - Last few years we have experienced a difficultly in getting workers
 - May have to increase hourly rate?
 - Switch to new machines- all employees need to be trained



Recommendation

- Reduce polling places from 4 to 2
 - Meadow
 - Jackson
- Bold Systems will re organize voting books and mail new location to all registered voters
 - Organize by zip code
 - Williston Park, Albertson, Roslyn Heights vote at Meadow
 - Mineola, Garden City Park vote at Jackson
- Estimated savings this year-\$1,600
