Other Baseline Information

- Read literary passages linked by a common theme with multiple-choice and constructed-response questions.
 - Collect a writing sample.
 - Data is analyzed to determine needs in areas of reading comprehension, writing, and analyzing the use of literary elements in a text.

Areas of focus include close and careful reading of texts of increasing complexity and using text-based evidence in developing responses.


