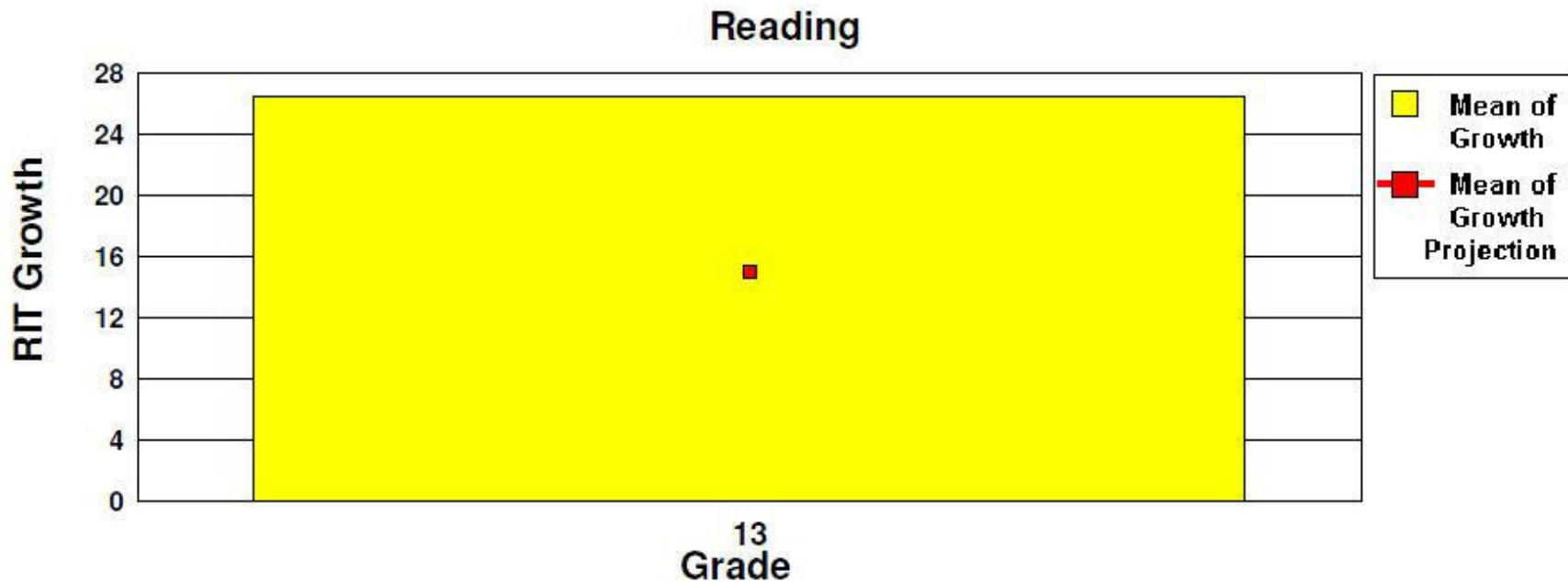

Reading



- Kindergarten mean growth exceeded projected growth by 76.7%.
- The projected mean growth was 15, kindergarten's actual mean growth was 26.5.
- 200 students met growth projection.

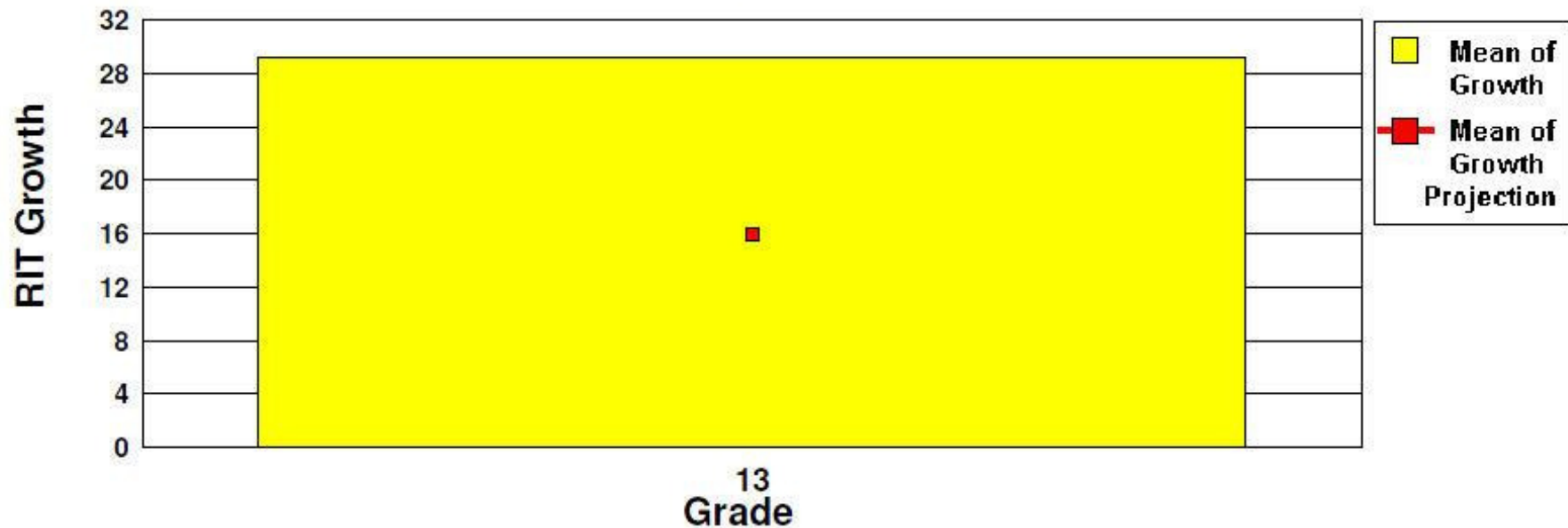

- The projected mean growth was 15.9, kindergarten's actual mean growth was 29.2.
- 199 students met growth projection.

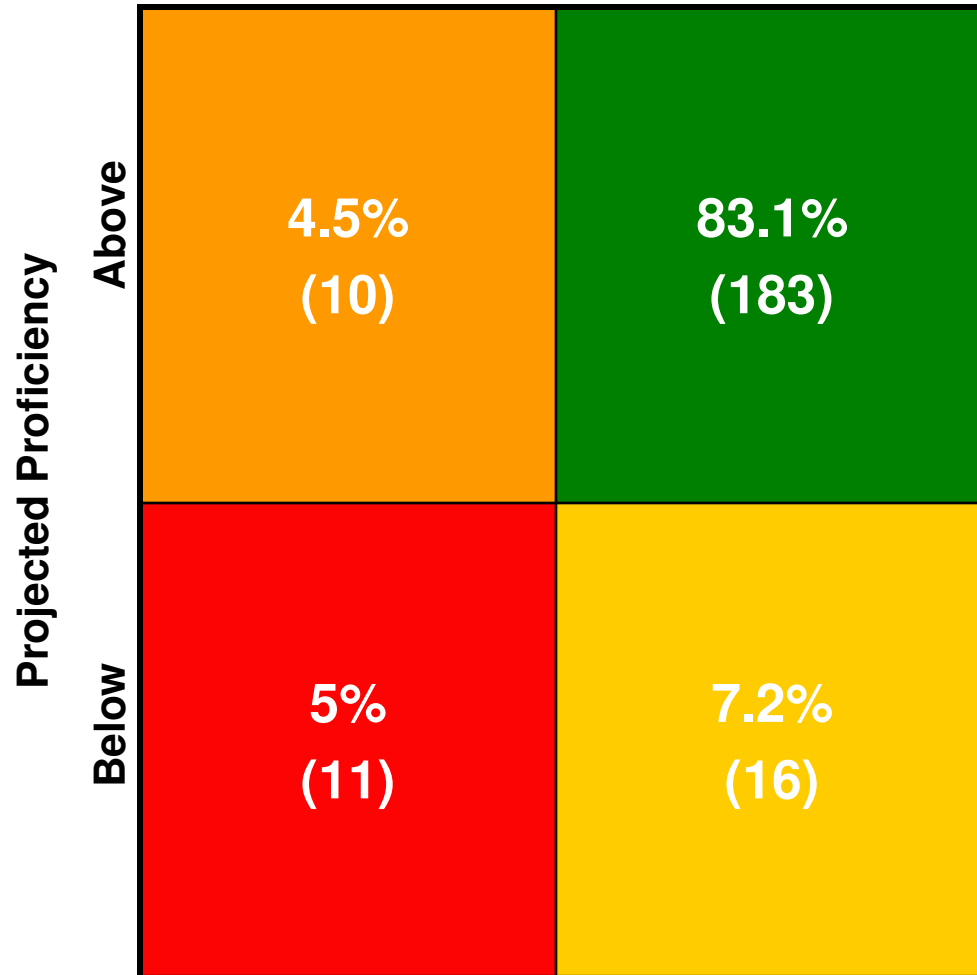


Quadrant by School-Math
