2012-2013 Budget

- What is different for 2012-2013 Budget?
 - School Districts in New York State know the maximum amount of the tax levy that they can use to pay for their annual budgets.
 - Mineola is permitted to increase its tax levy by 1.93%, or \$1,443,803

2011-2012	Tax Levy	\$74,798,377
2012-2013	Tax Levy	76,242,180

 Therefore, Districts now determine their budgets based on the TOTAL estimated revenues they will receive for the budget year.



2012-2013 Estimated Revenue

State Aid (as of 3/1/12) \$ 4,970,000

Other Income <u>2,130,000</u> 7,100,000

Maximum Tax Levy <u>76,242,180</u>

Budget cannot exceed \$83,342,180



Transfer to Capital

2011-2012 - We transfer 2,100,000 from 'savings' into our budget

Not a Levy expense

2012-2013 - We are recommending another transfer to Capital of \$600,000 for Meadow Library and Jackson Bus Loop.



Budget Including Transfer

Budget cannot exceed \$83,342,180

Transfer <u>600,000</u>

\$83,942,180

•Doesn't change Levy Cap because it is a transfer from 'savings'.



Budget Comparison

Proposed Operating Budget 2012-13 \$83,342,180

Add: Transfer to Capital 600,000

Total 2012-13 Budget 83,942,180

Current Budget 2011-12 84,221,638

Decrease (279,458) % Decrease (.03%)



Budget Factors

Draft Budget 3/15/12 \$83,431,100

Maximum Levy Cap Budget 2012-13 83,342,180

Excess over maximum 88,920

Current Draft Budget Reflects:

- Staffing
 - 2 Administrative Retirements
 - 1 Teacher Retirement
 - 2 Maintainer Positions
- All employees eligible for step received the increase
- No change in Programs
- Increase in Technology Initiatives

Does not reflect staffing changes as a result of closing Willis Ave. in September 2012.
