# ipad Replacement plan

- Expected life
  - 5 years (with case)
- Plan to have seniors ipad be 'obsolete' when they gradate
  - Require new devices for 8<sup>th</sup> graders
  - After we establish market value:
    - Allow them to purchase ipad if they wish
    - Or sell back to a company
- Then issue new devices to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade when entering Jackson
- This plan purchases 500 ipads;
  - 200 for grade 3
  - 200 for grade 8\*\*
  - 100 for teacher replacement
  - Mac book airs for Fab Lab



# Other equipment

- 35 new projectors with ceiling mounts
- 125 Chrome books with carts
  - 1 cart per building(coding)
- New switches
- New servers
- New PC laptops for Fab Lab



#### Two different 'loans' with BOCES

- This evening Board is voting on approving Apple purchasing
  - With financing and fees approx. \$65,000 per year
- June 2 meeting- all other equipment
  - With financing and fees approx. \$50,000 per year
