BELOW the NYS Tax Cap

The Board has applied funds from our fund balance to bring the tax levy below our allowable cap.

Curricular Enhancements

Elementary:

- Full day pre-K program
- New math program, K-6
- New enrichment program and AGP acceleration sequence

Middle School:

- Grade 7 Dual-Language

Districtwide:

- All current educational and co-curricular programs
- All extracurricular activities including all current athletic programs
- Maintains comprehensive staff development and professional development
- Continued expansion and replacement of district's technology program



Facility Upgrades

- Districtwide floor/carpet replacement - HS gym floor, MS water seal, JA steps, HS robotics room
- Additional cameras districtwide

Equipment Updates

- New furniture for 14 classrooms districtwide
- New fitness room equipment
- New furniture for pre-K rooms
- E-rate tech purchase

This budget includes a **\$4 million** transfer to capital. These monies will be used for various purposes districtwide, including:

- HS parking lot, sidewalk, curbs and entrance.
- Baseball practice facility.
- Modernization of stage lighting, electricity and rigging at Middle School and High School.
- Interior door replacement at Meadow, Hampton and High School.
- High School cafeteria renovation.
- Begin High School science room renovation plan.

BOARD CANDIDATES

In addition to voting on the budget, this year residents will be electing one candidate to the Board of Education. The seat that will be voted on, at large, is the one currently occupied by Cheryl Lampasona. Only one candidate has turned in petitions for the seat, so no Candidates Outreach will be mailed. 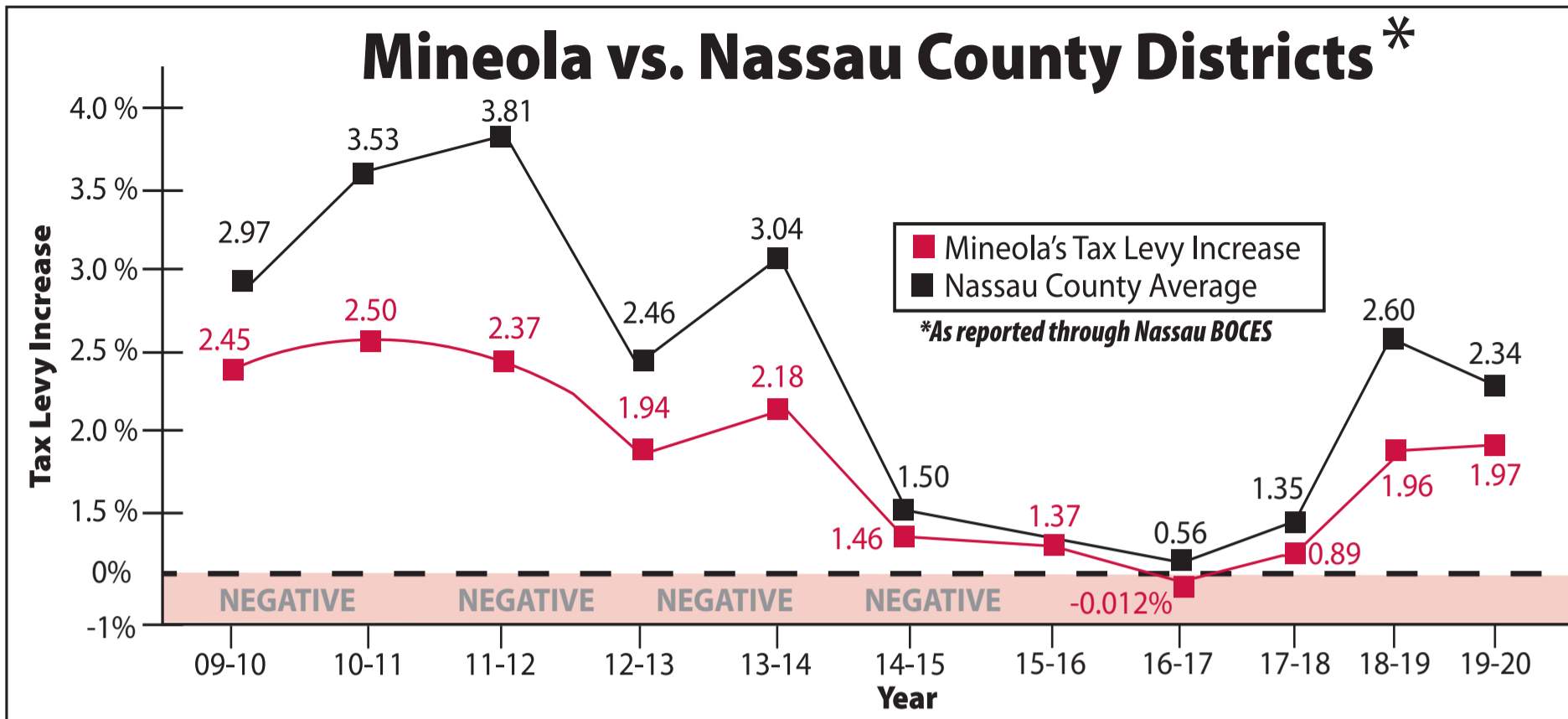

VOTER INFORMATION

VOTING REQUIREMENTS

To participate in the May 21, 2019 budget vote and Board election:

- You must be a registered voter who is a United States citizen 18 years of age or older, and a district resident for at least 30 days prior to the vote.
- You need not register if, during the last four years, you voted in a general election in Nassau County, voted in a Mineola Union Free School District election, registered with the Nassau County Board of Elections, or registered with the Mineola Union Free School District.

WHEN AND WHERE TO REGISTER

From now through May 16, 2019, registration is continuous for new residents and those who have had a change of address, Monday through Friday from 11 AM to 3 PM in the Superintendent's Office, located at 121

Jackson Avenue, second floor. There will be a special registration opportunity on the evening of Tuesday, May 7, 2019 from 4 PM to 8 PM at Willis.

WHEN AND WHERE TO VOTE

Voting will take place on Tuesday, May 21 between the hours of 6 AM and 9 PM at either Jackson Avenue or Meadow Drive.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

If you will be out of the country or unable to vote in person on May 21, you can apply for an absentee ballot. Applications for absentee ballots are available in the Superintendent's Office, located at 121 Jackson Avenue, second floor. You may either call 516.237.2002 to have an application mailed to you, come into the office to pick one up in person, or download a copy from the district website at www.mineola.k12.ny.us.
