Completed Capital IMPROVEMENTS



With some modifications to meet health and safety guidelines the last six months, capital improvements around the district were able to continue and be completed prior to the start of a new school year. Due to fiscally responsible long-term planning, all of these projects were able to be completed without the need for a bond and at no additional cost to our taxpayers. - New parking lot at Meadow Drive.
- New parking lot at Mineola Middle School.
- Completion of high school athletic complex.
- Interior work on art, music and science rooms at Jackson Avenue.
- Completion of lighting and multimedia additions at both Mineola High School auditorium and Mineola Middle School auditorium.

- These auditorium projects, technically completed in March of 2020, feature theatrical lighting fixture updates, addition of a truss similar to that in a Broadway theater, renovated rigging systems,

new curtains and the addition of a video system to simulcast events. The high school project also included a multimedia system with four large screens, cameras and projectors.
