2023-24 Charge Policy for School Meals

Charging for school meals refers to when a student does not have enough money to cover the price of a meal at the point of sale. Charges for meals are discouraged but are permitted for students who occasionally forget or misplace their money up to a MAXIMUM of:

Preschool – 12th grade Students - \$10.00

Reminder – per the State of Ohio, family's that qualify for reduced-priced meals will be receiving FREE meals this school year which applies to breakfast and lunch. There will be no charges allowed reduced this year.

We do not allow charges for a-la-carte items such as snacks or extra meal items.

If a charge should happen, please repay the charge amount the following day. If a student happens to reach the charge limit, Mississinawa Valley Schools will not let a child go hungry. We will offer the student a peanut butter sandwich and a milk (emergency meal) for that day.

NOTIFICATION OF LOW BALANCE:

- Parents can use the automatic notification on PaySchools Central www.payschoolscentral.com **free of charge**. This is quick and easy to set-up once you are signed into your PaySchools Central account. You won't have to worry about missing a note your child brings home should they need lunch money.
- Negative/low balance messages will be sent through the One-Call system to parents/guardians. Please take care of negative balances the next school day.

Charging is not permitted during the last two weeks of the school year.

All student meal accounts need to be at a zero or positive balance at the end of the school year. If there happens to be an unpaid meal charge at the end of the school year, it will be carried over to the next year. Any graduating seniors must have charge balances paid before graduation.
