### ACT WorkKeys 2019

- ACT WorkKeys is a job skills assessment system that helps employers select, hire, train, develop, and retain a high-performance workforce.
- Successful completion of ACT WorkKeys assessments in Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information can lead to earning ACT's National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC), a portable credential earned by more than 1 million people across the United States. Students scoring a Silver Level or higher earn this credential.
- This is no longer a requirement as of the 2019-2020 school year.
