Important Information for Juniors - Class of 2024

Juniors will take the ACT with writing at MBHS on March 14, 2023, and will receive more information about how to register through their English class. We recommend that students take the ACT at least twice. Visit www.act.org to register for additional test administrations and to view testing dates through next fall.*

Here is some information you may find helpful:



Auburn University

- Application for admission available on August 1st.
- No specific minimums published for admission. If you have questions about admission or requirements, please contact Mrs. Svetlay or Mrs. Voltz.
- Admission decisions generally made by March of student's senior year.
- Auburn will superscore the ACT for admission and scholarship purposes BUT will NOT accept the ACT superscore report. Send all score reports that make up your superscore through ACT.

> Scholarship consideration:

- Merit scholarships begin approx. at a 28 ACT and a 3.5 GPA (weighted or unweighted).
- Spirit of Auburn Presidential Scholarship (\$10,500) awarded at 33 ACT and 3.5 GPA (weighted or unweighted).
- For additional consideration, complete AUSOM application. Priority Deadline mid-January (1st semester senior grades are not included). Last guaranteed standardized test considered for scholarships will be December ACT or November SAT.
- Honors College consideration 3.85 GPA, 29 ACT or higher, and completed application. Auburn will send applications to students who qualify.



University of Alabama

- Application for admission usually available in mid-July. Typically, students apply in the fall of senior year.
- General admission usually around a 21 on the ACT* and a 3.0 GPA (weighted or unweighted)
- Alabama will superscore the ACT for admission purposes but not for scholarship consideration

> Scholarship consideration (NO superscore accepted):

- Merit scholarships begin at 21 ACT and 3.5 GPA or 25 ACT and 3.0 GPA (weighted or unweighted).
- Full tuition scholarship awarded at 30 ACT and 3.5 GPA (weighted or unweighted).
- For additional consideration, complete scholarship application through your mybama account.

- Honors College consideration 30 ACT and 3.5 GPA, requires separate application available through mybama account. Students without minimum requirements may be recommended.
