GRADING AND ASSESSMENT

- Most essays will take at least several weeks to complete.
- Total points earned will determine the percentage grade at the end of the grading period.

ABSENCES

For **Excused** absences, a student will have THREE (3) days to schedule/make up quizzes, tests, and minor assignments. Work missed during an **Unexcused** absence will not be accepted.

MAKING UP WORK

ALL WORK & ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE LOCATED ON SCHOOLGY

- **Major Essay** due dates - Usually submitted to turnitin.com - do not change due to absences. These dates are set in advance and can be submitted electronically.
- **Daily Assignments** turned in late will receive half credit
- **Major Assessments** Students are expected to make up their quizzes or tests the day they return (even if you have to come early).
- All short missed quizzes can be made up in my room before school or during 1st or 8th period by appointment.

LATE WORK

Assignments DUE are expected **on time** regardless of *how* the assignment is due. In person or virtual assignments will indicate due dates to which you must adhere.

- **Missing Work** will have an MA in the grade book - this counts as a zero.
- **Daily Assignments** turned in late will receive half credit
- **Major Assessments** will lose 10% per calendar day (including weekends) and will receive a zero on the third day unless arrangements have been made with your teacher.

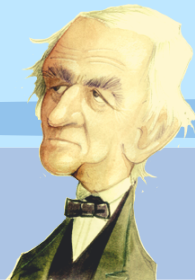
