As we enter the first weekend of February, we want to take a moment and update you on our latest COVID data and some great things going on inside our school buildings. We're pleased to report that our COVID numbers are trending downward.

Today, we are monitoring 36 total positive COVID cases in our district as well as 20 individuals who have been designated as a close contact. We've seen 51 individuals be able to return to school this week because of the <u>isolation/quarantine guidelines</u>. We're very encouraged by this decline in case numbers and ask that you continue to be vigilant to ensure a safe learning environment for our students and staff.
