When to Ask	Questions
<p style="text-align: center;">Before Reading</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you look at the pictures and predict what will happen in this story? • What characters do you think might be in this story? • What's the setting of this story? Where do you think it will take place? • Do you think this story will relate to our family?
<p style="text-align: center;">During Reading</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you think will happen next? • What can you tell me about the story so far? • What would you have done if you were the character? • I really connected to the story when I read the part about _____. It reminded me of _____. What are your connections to the story? • What are you wondering about so far? • Can you summarize (put into your own words) what we just read?
<p style="text-align: center;">After Reading</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Let's think back to the title of the story. Do you think that's a good title for the story? • Were your predictions correct? • Was there a problem in story? How did they solve the problem? • Use your own words to retell what happened in the story. • Was there a character in the story that's like you? • Did you like this book? • What was your favorite part of the story?
