Questions for Reading

When to Ask	Questions
Before Reading	 Can you look at the pictures and predict what will happen in this story? What characters do you think might be in this story? What's the setting of this story? Where do you think it will take place? Do you think this story will relate to our family?
During Reading	 What do you think will happen next? What can you tell me about the story so far? What would you have done if you were the character? I really connected to the story when I read the part about It reminded me of What are your connections to the story? What are you wondering about so far? Can you summarize (put into your own words) what we just read?
After Reading	 Let's think back to the title of the story. Do you think that's a good title for the story? Were your predictions correct? Was there a problem in story? How did they solve the problem? Use your own words to retell what happened in the story. Was there a character in the story that's like you? Did you like this book? What was your favorite part of the story?
